OUR 70-YEAR CCVI STORY

The Kansas City Nursery School for the Blind opened in September 1952. One teacher, assisted by volunteer classroom aides from the Junior League and Delta Gamma alumnae, taught the first class of eight blind and five sighted children. The school's name was changed in 1982 to Children's Center for the Visually Impaired (CCVI). Over the last 70 years, CCVI has educated more than 12,000 children who are blind or visually impaired and their families.

Children's Center for the Visually Impaired has become a staple in the community. It is one of less than seven privately-funded schools in the country to provide its services and programs to populations of children with visual impairments.
